I am writing to express my concerns and objection for proposed wheelie bin access via easement on 2 Dorset street Ashgrove and kerbside/road collection point for these bins in front of the same address.

My reasons for objecting to this proposal is that it will take up 2 street parking spaces out the front of our unit complex and the possible removal of 2 parking spaces on the easement of 2 Dorset street. I am a current cancer patient undergoing treatment at the Brisbane Mater Hospital and rely on this car parking close to home. I am regularly exhausted and weak due to cancer treatment and walking short distances is tiring and stressful. I am currently at high risk of cancer returning in the next three years and I am not considering moving residence during this time. The parking on Dorset street is highly sought after at the best of times. The elimination of these two street spaces for 24 hours once a week and possible elimination of the 2 easement spaces will heavily impact my ability to comfortably access my unit.

I support extra housing in the Brisbane area and suggest wheelie bin access for the proposed development be redirected outside the property of 193 Waterworks road. I have observed other Waterworks road residents do the same.
