

Good morning,
Regarding the proposal for changes to 514 Algester Road, Parkinson.

I am objecting to the changes to this address to allow for a Health Care Service and Dwelling Unit.

Currently we have a high volume of traffic on Algester Road due to many people "rat running" to avoid the lights on Beaudesert Road. The additional traffic problems will cause more accidents, and be dangerous for people who disembark the bus and cross the road.

The opening of the Wings child care centre on Algester road, which is 2 doors up from this proposed Health Care Centre is going to create its own traffic problems.
Unless a centre island is placed in front of the child care centre there will be parents turning across a double white line.
This will potentially cause more accidents and congestion.

We currently have doctors premises across the road at the Parkinson Medical Centre. There is also doctors premises at both ends of Algester road, just off Ridgewood Road and at the top end of Nottingham Road.

There won't be enough street parking for the patients attending so more people will park at the shopping centre and be trying to cross the road.

Please don't let this change go ahead as the roads are dangerous enough now. More traffic, congestion and being so close to the bus stop is going to create problems.
